With this inaugural issue, we are happy to launch a new, open-access, peer-reviewed journal *New Horizons in English Studies*. The journal will be published annually and will focus primarily on scholarship by undergraduate, graduate, and doctoral students.

The idea of the journal was conceived of following the success of the *Students' Corner: Language, Literature and Culture* conference series, organized by the Students' Association at the Department of English Studies at Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin, Poland, since 2015. Our objective, as the Board of Editors, is therefore to reflect on this broad range of meanings and disseminate research that orients itself towards the "new horizons" across our field(s).

We hope that *New Horizons in English Studies* will reach a greater international visibility in the coming years. We thank our contributors, editors and reviewers for their work and support. On behalf of the Editorial Board we would like to encourage our readers to consider the journal as a venue for publication. Calls for Papers will be announced on the journal's website.
