The day of November 30, 2019, will always remain in our memories as one of the most tragic dates in the history of the Department of Constitutional Law of Maria Curie-Skłodowska University in Lublin. We appreciated Wojtek as an outstanding scholar, capable Head of the Department, and first and foremost as a good, friendly man, our Colleague and Friend.

Herewith, we give the Readers a volume comprising studies written to pay homage to the memory of Professor Wojciech Orłowski, covering mostly the constitutional and systemic issues on which his scientific interests focused.
